Since this is a first time offering by the States of Oregon, basically only issuing landowner tags. The outfitter that I used is long time area resident and has the leases with the landowners for the best properties that hold the highest numbers of these special Columbia whitetail deer. I believe he will only take about 8 hunters per year. He makes sure everything is pre-scouted and that your landowner tag is on a really good property to give you the best opportunity for a good buck. We passed up several smaller bucks before deciding on the one I took and I only hunted for two days.
